July 4th Service in the Memorial Garden





This weekend the General Convention of the Episcopal Church is meeting in Baltimore. General Convention is the legislative body of our denomination. The Episcopal Church has bishops just as the Roman Catholic Church does, but our church does not have the equivalent to the papacy or the magisterium. Churchwide decisions are made by the elected body called General Convention. The Convention has two houses: The House of Bishops (made up of all bishops working and retired) and The House of Deputies (elected clergy and lay people from diocesan conventions around the Episcopal Church). All major decisions like the national church budget or revising the prayer book, needs to pass both houses of Convention.

Normally, Convention takes place every three years, but last year was postponed because of the outbreak of the Delta variant. Despite lower COVID numbers this year, it was still decided to keep convention to only 4 days vs. 10 days. All in-person worship and social gatherings were canceled. Only the legislative sessions will be in-person this year.

The resolutions are wide-ranging. Two issues that will be discussed are the church's role in racial reconciliation and healing, and if the convention will permit General Theological Seminary to affiliate with Virginia Theological Seminary. This affiliation would allow for General to be largely ran by VTS but keep its historic New York City presence. Blessings,
