Next week, November 3rd, we will be celebrating All Saints' Sunday. All Saints' Day is one of the high feasts in our church. At the 10:00am Eucharist, we will have the Premiere Brass Quartet joining us. Having brass as part of worship is special as well as festive. All Saints' Dav is a feast which is probably older than Christmas - only behind Pentecost and Easter. The day was originally celebrated in the Spring when it was called All Martyrs' Day. This reflects the very real experience of persecution that early Christians faced. As the years went on, the church decided that it wanted a special day to celebrate all the saints (certainly including the martyred ones). All Saint's Day is the highlight of three straight days of Christian observance. All Hallows' Eve is of Old English origin, and with some help from the Scots language, was eventually contracted to Hallowe'en. All Saints' Day, similar to Christmas, was a feast that encouraged people to visit their neighbors. It was traditional to visit one's neighbors singing songs (perhaps even doing short skits) and bringing and receiving food and drink. The traveling party would often raise money for some charitable purpose. The day after All Saints' Day is All Souls' Day. This day remembers all of the departed. We will not have a Eucharist on All Souls' this year, as Linda Brockman's funeral will be that day. We will pray the list of the honored dead at the Wednesday Eucharist on November 6th. We will pray for those who have died since last All Saints' Day, on All Saints' Sunday.
