

Today is Rose Sunday, one of our two refreshment Sundays during the church's penitential seasons. The Rose Sunday during Lent is also Mothering Sunday. The practice of visiting one's "mother church" has been practiced since the Middle Ages. While all children celebrated their mothers and mother churches, the holiday was especially meaningful for those who were off to school or in domestic service. Lenten Soup Supper Series – Please join us for the Lenten Soup Supper Series on Thursday evening from **March 13th through April 10th from 6 pm to 8 pm**. This year, Deacon Scott will be leading a program he has developed entitled "Living Our Baptismal Promises". We will delve into the implications of the five Baptismal promises contained in the Baptismal Covenant (*Book of Common Prayer*, pp. 304-305) for our daily life and ministry both as individuals and as a congregation. Please join us for a light supper and interesting conversation!

Undie Sunday - This year we will share what we've collected in underwear, socks and cash/check donations with social service department East Hartford, Manchester Area Conference of Churches (MACC) in Manchester and the elementary school nurses in Vernon.

- For the East Hartford community: The town's social service department will use cash/checks to purchase (and distribute) needed underwear and socks.
- For the Manchester community: MACC is asking for summer socks for women, men and kids; women's medium and large undies; men's medium, large and extra-large boxers; and kid undies of all sizes up to a size 12.
- For the Vernon community: the five elementary school nurses are asking for girls' and boys' undies sizes 4t to 14/16, especially sweatpants 5t to 16 and girls leggings 5t to 16. There is a marked collection box in the Narthex. We also accept cash and check donations to purchase additional items. If making cash or check donation, please complete the donation form found on the table in the Narthex and place it in the offering plate or mail it to the church. Please make out checks to St. John's with Undie Sunday on the memo line.
